English Language and Arts

Phonics - students learned words that have the initial sound /o/. They also came up with their own words that have the /o/ sound whether at the beginning, middle or at the end.

We also watched a short story about the letter Oo.

Through this activity, their listening

skills will flourish. They will have the Word Mapping activity. It also will enhance their ability to comprehend the short story. Every phonics day, students practice reading CVC words. This is one of the first steps for them to learn reading.

Communication – the skills that we focused on are speaking and writing. We discussed about the family, particularly the different members of the family. In this topic, I integrated related topics such as occupations. As we move forward with this topic, sports and hobbies will be discussed.

Life Studies- students' learned the different parts of a plant. We watched a short movie showing the process of how these parts evolve. We went outside to have them draw their Morning glories and label the parts as an activity.

Mathematics - this week students' learned expressions on Subtraction.
