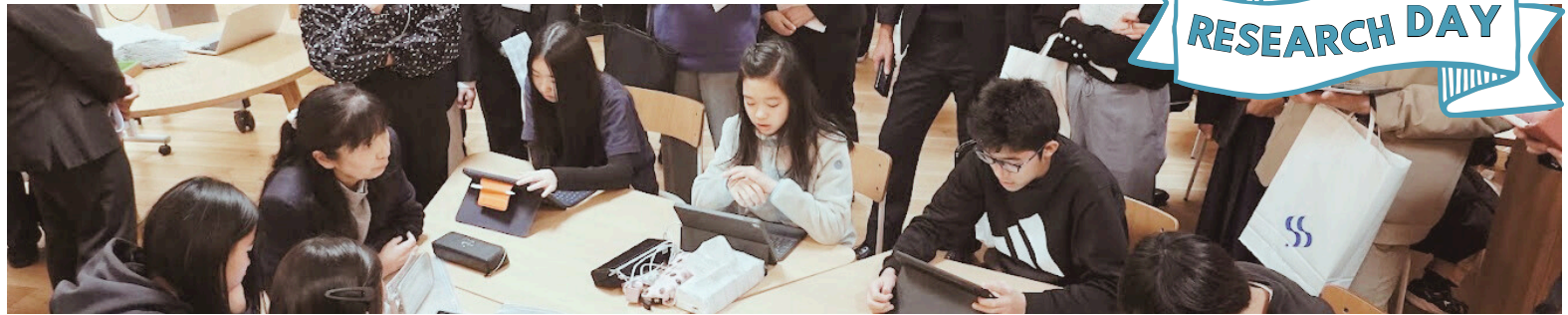


SOLAN HARMONY
